Hair Sample:

- Pull 30-50 hairs from the mane or tail, pulling 5-10 hairs at a time.
- Make sure there are some pulled hairs with a bulb or follicle at the end. (This is where we obtain the DNA.)
- Do not use shedded hairs (from brush, etc.).
- Align the bulb ends of the pulled hairs together and trim other end so that sample is 3-4 inches long.
- Tape hair on paperwork and do not tape over follicle.



- Place in standard envelope labeled with horse's ID. Send via First Class Mail or Express, if desired.
- All samples originating outside the United States MUST be accompanied by a USDA import permit. Please contact Dr. Kathy Graves, (859) 218-1193, ktgraves@uky.edu.

Please allow 3 weeks from the receipt of sample.
